Medicare's Open Enrollment period gives people with Medicare the opportunity to make changes to their health plan or prescription drug plan, pick a Medicare Advantage plan, or return to Original Medicare (also referred to as Medicare Part A and Part B). Medicare plans can change their offerings and costs every year, and individuals' health needs can change from year-to-year, too. Now is the time for people with Medicare to review their coverage options and make a choice that best meets their health care needs. Your local Area Agency on Aging's State Health Insurance Assistance Program (SHIP) will be available to help you:

- Read the Annual Notice of Changes mailed to you by your health plan.
- Check the plan formulary—the list of covered prescription drugs—to make sure yours are covered.
- Have a Medicare Advantage plan? Check to see that your providers are still in the plan's network and if there are any changes in co-pays.
- Look for plans that best meet your changing health, life, and financial needs. Protect against Medicare fraud.
